

Chiseldon Tennis Club is situated at the top corner of the Recreation Field, behind the football pitch. Access is via Norris Close.

We have 3 lovely purple and green courts that are floodlit for year round play and a clubhouse. It is a members club but one of the courts is available for ' pay and play'. This court can be booked through Chiseldon House Hotel, a refundable deposit is required for the key and it costs £10 for an hours play. We are very grateful to the hotel for offering this service.

We play mens, ladies and mixed teams in the Swindon & District Winter and Summer Leagues at various levels and although a small club are proud to have 3 different teams playing in their respective top divisions.

We have 2 Club Recreation sessions a week- Wednesdays from 6.30pm and Sundays from 10.30am.

All members are welcome to these sessions to play at all levels from beginners onwards as well as being able to use the courts at ant other time. Anyone thinking of joining is very welcome to come to a couple of sessions to try us out!
