## **PLANNING ISSUES**

- (1) Proposal site is part of the North Wessex Downs AONB which has legal protection as of both local and national interest to protect these areas from development.
- (2) This status is reinforced by the latest government policy statement (Development Plan and National Panning Policy (NPPF))
- (3) Swindon Borough own Local Plan clearly states
- **Policy SD2** The proposed development would not be within rural settlement boundary.
- **Policy EN2** The proposed development will undoubtedly contravene the objectives of the Great Western Community Forest.
- Policy EN5

  The proposed development represents an isolated suburban incursion into the landscape of a protected character. The development will be visible from New Road, Liddington Hill and Barbury Castle with particular relevance to light pollution in open country side (policy EN4) adjacent to the Chiseldon/Marlborough railway line County Wildlife Site
- Policy HA1 The Borough villages are under no obligation to provide for the overall housing needs of the Borough. The type of proposed housing is speculative major development and in little way represents the housings need of Chiseldon.
- Policy TR2 The proposal will add to the congestion of New Road and the two junctions onto the Swindon/Marlborough road (New Road and Ridgeway). In particular the accesses (road and pedestrian) onto New Road adversely impact around the build out and majority of movements onto New Road will involve a 'zig zag' right out of the site and left into the village (Station Road and Castle View). The south side of the proposal will access on the Ridgeway with poor site lines and involve residents turning on and off the Swindon/Marlborough Road merely to access 'their' village.

# Policy SD1 Sustainability

The Minister himself states:

"means ensuring better lives for ourselves and not worse lives for future generations"

This proposed development is an incursion into open countryside to the detriment of future generation's enjoyment.

## Policy EN6

Flood risk is not confined to the south of the site. Local knowledge shows significant incidences of flooding to the north of the site almost onto New Road filling the ditches which are proposed to be paved over. Whilst we appreciate the investigations made on this aspect, they appear to be flawed.
