### Neighbourhood Watch

# Fire Engine Routes

The Dorset and Wiltshire Fire & Rescue Service have sent round a communication reminding everyone that they need the width of 2 cars (3 metres) to be able to access a street with their vehicles.

They have asked everyone to consider whether a smarter parking option, maybe a bit further away is available. Other tips to help include making sure wing mirrors are folded in, making sure corners are kept clear and on narrow roads trying to only park on one side of the road.

# Crimes of opportunity

The latest crime report from our local PC has shown a low level of crime from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 7<sup>th</sup> November. During this time there were 2 dwelling burglaries and 1 shed/garage burglary where in 2 instances the building was unsecured.

There were 4 cases of interference with a vehicle, in all cases the vehicles were left insecure.

PC Sophia Best has reminded everyone to ensure homes and vehicles are locked at all times to prevent opportunist thefts.

# Butts Road Closure for re-surfacing

The current proposed date for the re-surfacing of Butts Road is 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018. The road will be closed to vehicle traffic for this time.

# New Road Layby

At the time of going to press, work continues by Swindon Borough Council on the construction of the new layby at New Road. We hope that work concludes shortly, leaving a new parking area, with the footpath moved to accommodate these changes.

# Public to be given chance to learn more about planning process

The complexities of the local planning process will be explained in two training sessions organised by Swindon Borough Council. The Council's planning team will be on hand to run through how planning applications are determined as well as navigate people through local planning policy.

The session will be held on Monday, 27 November and will be of particular interest to anyone who would like to know a bit more about Local and Neighbourhood Plans as well as the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). Phil Smith, the Council's Strategic Planning Policy Manager, will explain how the UK planning system is structured and the role of the Council as the Local Planning Authority. Swindon Borough Council's Local Plan 2026 and Local Plan Review will be discussed as will the borough's five-year housing supply and Neighbourhood Planning.

# Home Close Nature Area

Update – the area will be cleared shortly in an "initial" cut to ensure access to the drainage pipes over the winter months. Two maintenance cuts will then happen throughout the year to keep the area accessible yet natural in appearance.

### New Road proposed new housing development

At the time of going to print the Parish Council have still not received confirmation from Swindon Borough Council that a formal planning application has been received regarding the proposed development on New Road. We will ensure we inform residents of any information we receive and will arrange appropriate series of meetings at which all interested parties can attend.

### Planters update.

The Planters and soil are in place and bulbs for spring planted. Thank you to the volunteers who have helped us so far, and to the owners of the B&B on Station Road who are going to look after the 2 at the entrance to Chiseldon Village on New Road.

We will be arranging regular "minders" for the planters over the winter months ready for Spring.
