Neighbourhood Watch

Thefts from vehicles

There were 5 thefts from vehicles during August; all of these were from vehicles that were unlocked. Please remember to lock your vehicle at all times, even if it's on your driveway. It only takes an opportunist thief a couple of minutes to open a door and take something.

Please also keep any personal items out of view when in a vehicle, as a thief will think nothing of smashing a window to take a bag, phone or other valuables.

Butts Road Cemetery

For a number of years for various reasons the regulations at the Butts Road cemetery in regards to grave sites have not always been adhered to. This has been brought to the attention of the Parish Council so we will now begin a progress or bringing graves up to regulation standards starting with the removal of glass and ceramic items that may break and cause a hazard.

Our regulations are on our website, they are on the Chapel door in Butts Road, and can be requested from the Clerk. They will also be supplied with any new funeral arrangement paperwork.

We will endeavour to contact Next of Kin before making any changes to grave sites. If you have any concerns over a grave site you care for, or are next of kin for a grave site and the Council may not have your details then please get in touch with the Clerk.

The defibrillators have been delivered and our electrician has checked them over to see what extra parts and equipment he needs. We will then be talking to the 2 sites at the Dr's Surgery on Station Road and the Sports and Social Club on Draycott Road to arrange a suitable installation date.

Following on from that, a training session will be provided.

Castle View Play Area

Further repair and improvement works have been carried out in the play area over the last couple of weeks. The 2 new rockers will be ordered before the end of the month and the cost covers delivery and installation.

New Road proposed new housing development

At the time of going to print the Parish Council have still not received any applications through from Swindon Borough Council with regards to the proposed development on New Road. We will make the public aware of any information we receive and will hold meetings that all interested parties can attend.

Planters update.

We are currently finalising the last few queries with SBC over the location of the planters. Once the licence is approved we will order the planters and also the spring bulbs that will go in them. Hopefully we can then get our volunteer team on the case to plant them ready for some spring colour.

With regards to the flowers planted on the green area of Station Road/New Road, there were some concerns over the height of the flowers this year with regards to exiting the junction. The residents who plant these flowers will ensure that in future years a smaller plant is chosen, however they were upset to see that someone had taken it upon themselves to come along anonymously and cut down the flowers. In the spirit of being neighbourly perhaps a friendly chat would be more beneficial in the future.
