

Responsibilities within Chiseldon Parish

Chiseldon Parish Council:

Rubbish bin supply and empty

Dog waste bin supply and empty

Hedge cutting in 3 public locations – New Road near Canney Close; New Road near Patriot Arms, and Hodson Road near pedestrian entrance to Recreation field.

Grass cutting – most public areas except highway verges – including Castle View green area and play area. Cemeteries. Recreation Field.

Maintenance of Castle View Play area equipment

Most fly tipping – except hazardous waste

Maintenance of flower planters

Street cleaning with hand tools

Tree trimming with hand tools from ground level on trees owned by the Borough Council

Management of allotment

Management of Butts Road cemetery and Sir Henry Calley Memorial Garden

Maintenance of 1 bus stop shelter on Hodson Road, turning to Hodson.

Are consulted to give their view on Planning Applications and other Parish changes

Swindon Borough Council:

All other hedges in public spaces

Road resurfacing and potholes

Road verge maintenance – damage repair and grass cutting

Verge clearance with heavy machinery

Large fly tipping occurrences and hazardous waste

Drain clearing

Street Lighting

Road sign replacement or repairs

All other tree maintenance work

Repairs and maintenance to Council house properties

Maintenance of Bus stops/shelters (except Hodson Road turning to Hodson)

Make the decisions on planning applications.

Make decisions on speed limits/weight limits on roads - will consult with Parish Council.

Littering fines

Dog mess fines

Road line painting – bus bays, crossings, yellow lines etc

Traffic Lights

Highways England:

Potholes and road surface/safety issues on M4 and A419 only

Private residents:

All land, hedges, lawns and areas within their property boundary.

Responsible for ensuring no traffic obstruction or loss of view for road users due to overgrown trees/shrubs.

Any private roads, not managed by SBC

Washpool Area Restoration Project (WARP):

Voluntary fundraising group that maintain the Washpool area. Note: Land around the Washpool is privately owned with permitted rights of way. The Washpool is leased for public enjoyment.
