Dear Clair

I hope you can read and understand my workings !!

I have measured the carpark areas and have made an assessment of the extent of the work that will be required to create the above .I have involved Matt Frost who as you might know lives in the Parish and is very competent at carrying out this type of work .He has given me his labour costs that seem quite reasonable .

The heavy plant and materials will be supplied by Tithegrove at cost and we will get the benefits of their buying power .

The total estimated cost for the works I have described will be £9089.00. I think though that with my advised specification subject to ground conditions this sum is quite complete and it may be prudent to put 10 % on top for budgetary purposes.

My only reservation are the ground conditions i.e. how much topsoil there is and how far we will excavate to get to good bearing ground .I would like therefore next Thursday get my gardener to dig some small trial pits to check the ground conditions to finally confirm.
