M4 Burderop Wood over bridge survey works

Highways England plans, builds, operates and maintains England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know we will shortly be carrying out essential safety works on the Broome Manor Lane/Buerderop Wood bridge which carries traffic over the M4.

The works

Highways England's priority at the moment is to play its part in keeping the country safe and support the movement of essential supplies, services and people who cannot work from home. We continue to carry out necessary repairs on our roads in preparation for traffic flows returning to normal.

This bridge has deteriorated with age and is in need of essential safety works including, concrete repairs, waterproofing renewal, joint replacement and resurfacing. These major works are programmed to take place in autumn of this year and we'll contact you with details nearer the time. Ahead of this we neeed to carry out surveys to ensure we have captured all elements of the work required and in order to do this safely we'll need to close the bridge during daytime hours for 4 days. Please accept our apologies in advance for any disruption this causes.

Dates of work

Start – 1 June 2020 End – 4 June 2020

Burderop Wood bridge closure 7am to 6pm – there will be no access for motorists or pedestrians. A signed diversion will be in place via B4006 and A4259 (Marlborough Road) for those accessing from the Broome Manor area. A signed diversion will also be in place via B4005 and A436 for those accessing from the Burderop area.

We always aim to work to the programme, however unforseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions may mean changes to it. We will notify you of any major changes via advance roadside warning signs. We will make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community is kept to a minimum.
