Henge and stone circles

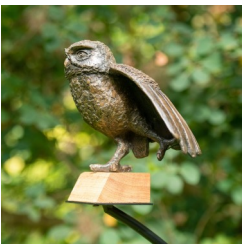
Why not take a guided tour around the largest stone circle in the world? Our expert guides can tell you all about the people who built it. The tour takes around an hour.

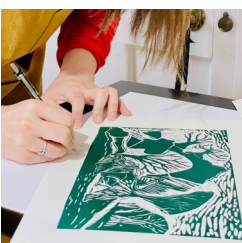


Landscape walks—East of Avebury

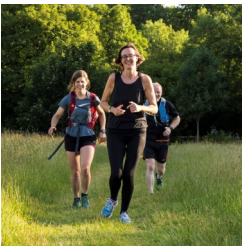


Half Term Activities
