Notes to Editors

- Swindon Carers Centre is part of the national network of the Carers Trust and is also affiliated to Carers UK.
- SCC offers support, help and information to people in Swindon who have caring responsibilities.
- An unpaid carer is a person who provides unpaid support to a family member, partner, friend, or neighbour who needs help because of an illness, frailty, disability, mental health condition or an addiction and cannot cope without their support.
- The 2021 Census showed there were 18,315 unpaid carers of all ages (including children and young people) in the borough of Swindon. The number of carers caring for longer hours (20 to 50 hours a week and also 50+ hours a week) increased.
- The financial value provided by unpaid carers in Swindon is £592 million a year, up by 43% on the previous decade and is the largest percentage increase in the South West of England.
