Avebury Manor Garden

The garden at Avebury Manor is arranged as a series of 'rooms', each with an individual style. Sit and relax in the quiet spaces. Completely accessible by wheelchair or mobility scooter.



Henge and stone circles

Why not take a guided tour around the largest stone circle in the world? An experienced guide will help bring the history of this ancient site to life. The tour takes about an hour.



Alexander Keiller Museum
